This means working on the two core areas of learning and training that BCDI focuses on: the creation and dissemination of learning materials, and the development of learning programs that advance leadership development, organizational change, and policy development for the Bronx. This position is a great fit for graduate students in education and teaching programs, trained facilitators (or those who want to become trained facilitators) storytellers, policy researchers, and planners who believe in the Bronx, New York, and the possibility and necessity of economic democracy.

Possible Projects

- Working with EDLC Director to develop curriculum modules for the revised edition of BCDI's curriculum for Economic Democracy.
- Development of written materials for a variety of audiences: scholarly, policy, industry, and general, that reinforce the values and vision of economic democracy and BCDI.
- Creation of graphic and visual materials that accompany the above.
